Notice of 30 Day Comment and Public Hearing

Lake County Mental Health (LCMH) is announcing the 30 day comment period from May 22 – June 20, 2009 for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Annual Plan Update and Capital Facilities and Technological Needs Plan for fiscal year 2009 – 2010. A public hearing is scheduled for 4:00pm on Thursday, June 25, 2009 at the Lake County Mental Health Clinic, located at 991 Parallel Drive in Lakeport, in the large conference room.

MHSA provides an array of services to those persons of all ages who suffer from, or are at risk of, severe mental illness. These services include full service partnerships with individual consumers in need of intensive, “whatever it takes” services to avoid hospitalization, incarceration or homelessness due to mental illness. MHSA provides general services such as the adult and transitional age drop-in centers as well as mental health services for those involved with the jail or juvenile justice systems. Others benefit from outreach and engagement to those populations deemed underserved or not served by traditional mental health services.
