Lake County Mental Health is announcing the 30-day comment period from October 29 – November 27, 2011 for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) FY 2010/11 Plan Update to the Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan for the Workforce Education and Training (WET), Innovation (INN), and Capital Facilities and Technological Needs (CFTN) components, as well as the MHSA Issue Resolution Process.

The Mental Health Services Act has been providing funding to Lake County since 2005 to support a variety of initiatives to assist consumers and their families in the local community. These initiatives include direct services and supports as well as prevention and early intervention programming. Input from consumers and their families, partner agencies, and representatives from cultural and ethnic populations in Lake County aided in the development of these programs through the Community Program Planning process as required by the Act. At this time, stakeholder participation is requested to further develop Workforce Education and Training, Innovation, and Capital Facilities & Technological Needs plans, as well as to provide input on the MHSA Issue Resolution Process.
